

• Entidad: Algo que puede identificarse claramente


• Relación: Una asociación entre dos o más entidades


• Atributo: Una característica que puede identificar instancias de entidades o relaciones





Diagramación de LRM





RDA 2020: ¿Qué sigue?

- A partir del 30 de abril de 2019, el sitio beta de RDA ya no está en revisión constante (al menos no el texto)
 - El texto en inglés ahora es estable para
 - Los vocabularios de valores (Esquemas de Codificación de Vocabulario)
 - El conjunto de elementos
 - La entidad y los capítulos de elementos
 - Los capítulos de orientación y recursos
 - Estabilización necesaria para
 - Traductores
 - Escritores de declaraciones de política
 - Desarrolladores de perfiles de aplicaciones
 - Escritores de materiales complementarios
 - Editor de ejemplos de RDA





RDA 2020: ¿Qué sigue?

- Modificación continuará por
 - Cambios menores editoriales
 - Corrección de errores tipográficos e inexactitudes
 - Consistencia
 - Mejor redacción para soportar traducciones
 - Otros cambios, si
 - Sin impacto significativo en traductores, redactors de declaraciones de políticas, etc.
 - Sin efecto sobre el resultado de la aplicación de las instrucciones
 - Adición y revision de ejemplos
 - Mejoras/Adiciones a la interfaz de Toolkit






RDA 2020: ¿Qué sigue?

- La versión "BETA" de RDA aún no es official
- Primero, debe suceder lo siguiente:
 - Finalización de traducciones claves (finlandés, francés, alemán, español)—objetivo: diciembre de 2019
 - Finalización y publicación de declaraciones de política—objetivo: febrero de 2020
 - RSC y la Junta de RDA deben acordar por unanimidad que el Proyecto 3R (revision de RDA y Toolkit) está complete
- Cuando se hace esa declaración, comienza un reloj de cuenta regresiva de un año
 - El RDA Toolkit original permanecerá active durante un año, luego de lo cual será retirado
- PCC y otros (bibliotecas nacionales, otras agencias) fijarán una fecha de implementación







Manifestation > title proper

title proper

Definition and Scope

A title of manifestation that is selected for preference in a specific application or context.

An alternative title is treated as part of a title proper.



Prerecording

A title proper does not include:

- Manifestation: other title information
- Manifestation: parallel other title information

A file name or data set name is not considered a *title proper* unless it is the only title appearing in the manifestation.

OPTION

Record an unstructured description using basic, normalized, or other transcription guidelines within a Manifestation: manifestation title
